# THE CONTINUING PANDEMIC CHALLENGE

This continues to be a very challenging time for schools. Ofsted, in their recent Covid Briefing\*, noted challenges for, and responses from, schools that included:

Curriculum and learning gaps Pupil absence Workload pressures for teachers and leaders Problems with supply Changing guidelines

The current pressures are acute, but we noted the briefing's comment that whilst 'there are more widespread adaptations to the curriculum to focus on core subjects...it's important that these adaptations are short term and do not slide into a more corrosive, longer-term narrowing of curriculum.' As cheerleaders for the arts, we have to agree.

In our support for the arts curriculum, Arts People is trying to respond to some of the issues facing schools. We have introduced online tuition, songwriting and literacy workshops and flexibility of, and additions to, tutor hours. We can offer all these to schools currently working with us and are looking forward to supporting schools as we enter the post-Covid period.

#### SONGWRITING AND LITERACY WORKSHOPS OFF TO A GREAT START



Our new songwriting and literacy workshops were trialled this term, after a summer of planning this addition to our workshops portfolio. We are delighted at the response. The comment "I would recommend this workshop for its links to both National Curriculum English and Music...Learning was clearly sequenced with high quality resources", from a Year 6 teacher summarised exactly what we were trying to achieve. With the pressures on the curriculum this year and probably beyond, we have designed these new Arts People workshops to be a time efficient and enjoyable way for pupils to build up their confidence in, and extend their understanding and knowledge of, both music and literacy.

The workshops run as a half-day or as a series of four, one hourly workshops, either in lesson time or after school. There are workshops already written on rhyming, similes, persuasive writing and narrative voice, but we would love to write more if asked.

At the end of the workshops, pupils will have a better understanding of the literacy focus, but they will also have been inspired by a successful singer-songwriter to appreciate music and write their own song.

Each workshop delivered by Arts People this year will rigorously risk assessed, with reference to DfE Covid-19 guidelines.
